# If you work on a building built before 1991

Make sure that an asbestos survey has been carried out in all the areas you will occupy on the worksite.

All areas containing asbestos must undergo decontamination before work begins.

# **Trades affected**

Structural work, electricity, plumbing, ceilings, carpentry, heating, roofing, building maintenance, waste disposal, landfills, etc.

## **Materials affected**

Fibre cement, plaster, tile adhesive, window putty, flooring, false ceilings, thermal insulation, flocking, lightweight panels, etc.

### **Asbestos-related diseases**

Pleural plaques, asbestosis, mesothelioma, lung cancer and other cancers
